Reader 4: Remember the people of this community, caring for the lowly and keeping us safe from all harm, that you may make good your purpose for us, filling us with the plentitude of your blessing. We give thanks to you, O God, with our whole heart; **because of your love and faithfulness.**

Reader 5: We are a sinful people in the presence of the Holy: Hear our prayers for those in need, especially (Add Prayer List). You have glorified your name and your Word above all things: Accept our praise and thanksgiving. Through the resurrection of Jesus Christ your love endures forever: Receive into your glorious presence those who have died. We give thanks to you, O God, with our whole heart; **because of your love and faithfulness.**
