Bless your Church and her members as we labour in your vineyard, that we may be fruitful, as we live our lives in a manner worthy of the gospel, and live faithfully in your loving presence. Holy One, you have bestowed upon your Church varieties of gifts through the same Spirit and given us varieties of service but the same Lord: Grant your people all gifts necessary for the upbuilding of your Body and the reconciliation of the world. Your love, O God, reaches to the heavens; **and your faithfulness to the clouds.**

Reader 2: Almighty One, your justice is like the great deep and your righteousness is like the strong mountains: Let your delight be upon our land, and fill our leaders with the goodness of your Spirit, that all nations may see your vindication and all leaders acknowledge your glory. Your love, O God, reaches to the heavens; **and your faithfulness to the clouds.**

Reader 3: Benevolent One, you give your people drink from the river of your delights: Fill our community with joy and fellowship, that we may nurture one another and celebrate our common life. Your love, O God, reaches to the heavens; **and your faithfulness to the clouds.**

Reader 4: Compassionate One, with you is the well of life, and in your light we see light: Be present throughout the world to protect and uphold all who live with poverty, disease, violence, or threat, that they may be delivered from their distress. Your love, O God, reaches to the heavens; **and your faithfulness to the clouds.**

Reader 5: Loving God, let your gracious healing power be with those for whom we pray, especially (Add Prayer List). Generous God, we offer to you our grateful praise, giving thanks. Never-failing God, we remember before you those who died. Your love, O God, reaches to the heavens; **and your faithfulness to the clouds.**

**(Together) God of abundance, as you turned the water into wine at the wedding feast of Cana, so let your transforming presence enliven our hearts and renew the world, that the earth may be filled with the power of your Spirit and be reconciled within the nurturing love of your Son, Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.**
