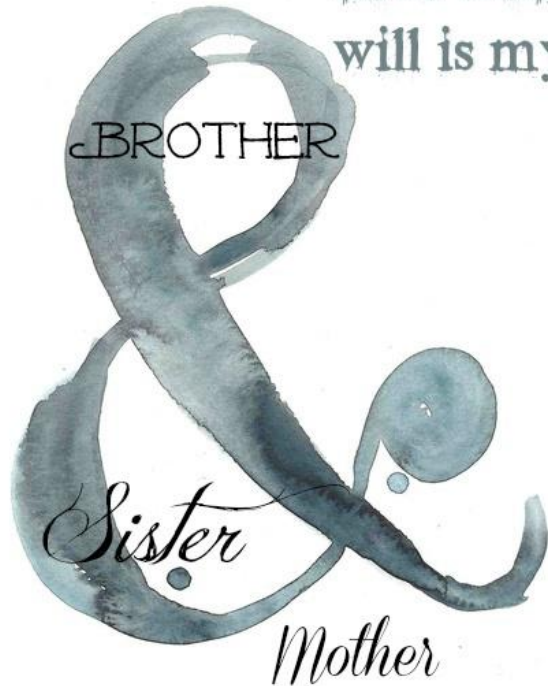

The Apostles' Creed

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE *Second Sunday after Pentecost*

Reader 2. Look upon the nations and all in authority as we struggle, harassed and helpless like sheep without a shepherd, O God: Pour out the abundance of your grace that we may become a priestly kingdom and a holy nation. You are good, O God; your mercy is everlasting; **and your faithfulness endures from age to age.**

Reader 3. Let your compassionate Spirit go forth throughout the world bringing good news and healing to all who live in poverty, oppression, violence or injustice, that they may be rescued and restored to wholeness and peace. You are good, O God; your mercy is everlasting; **and your faithfulness endures from age to age.**

Reader 4. Look upon our community as your treasured possession, and let everyone know your love poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us. You are good, O God; your mercy is everlasting; **and your faithfulness endures from age to age.**

Reader 5. Hear our prayers for those near and far, especially for all those in our parish. (Add Prayer List). We pray for the sick, those we know and those we do not know. We remember especially all suffering from the COVID virus and those suffering from the effects of isolation and job insecurity.. We entrust with hope those who have died that they may share the glory of God. Grant that suffering may produce endurance, and endurance produce character, and character produce hope that does not disappoint because of your love poured out through the Holy Spirit that

has been given to us. You are good, O God; your mercy is everlasting; **and your faithfulness endures from age to age.**

(Together): Mysterious and Holy Trinity, visit us with your grace and give new life and hope to all creation, that we may join in your reconciling work to bring your kingdom near, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
